The Arbor is a 501(c)(3) **nonprofit** organization. We are powered by the very community we serve.

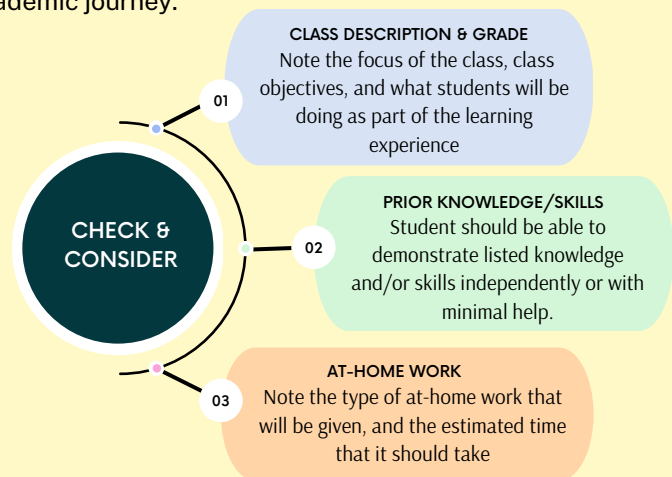
It's a Partnership
