

STUDENT ASSISTANT PROGRAM

REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 6+ in the 2024-2025 year
- Attended The Arbor for at least one previous year
- Grades 6-8: Interested students in grades 6-8 must be enrolled in at least one Arbor class on the same day of assisting.
- High School: Former Arbor students currently in grades 9+ will be considered for the student assistance program even without concurrent enrollment, as long as a family member is currently enrolled in the session they are assisting.
- Read through and agree to orientation materials as provided in **late August.**

APPLICATION & APPROVAL PROCESS

Students may apply to assist in **one period** per semester. Applications will be received on a rolling basis from **May 1st through August 16th** and will be considered for approval and assignment on a first-come, first-served basis.

STEPS:

- Complete the Student Assistant Program Application released on May 1st (see website). Applicants may go through an interview process.
- 2. Upon approval, applicants will be notified of assignments by **August 16th** at the latest. The family must review **and** confirm before our staff is able to finalize the assignment.

Please Note: Acceptance of application is not guaranteed. Care will be used in trying to best match a student's interests with program openings, but specific assignments cannot be guaranteed.
